PSC to Hold Public Hearings on Proposed Transmission Line from Fitchburg to Verona

Public Encouraged to Provide Comments

MADISON – The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) will hold public hearings in Fitchburg on Monday, September 24th regarding an application from American Transmission Company (ATC) to build a transmission line from Fitchburg to Verona.

Citizens are invited to provide testimony on ATC's request to build approximately 6 miles of new 138 kilovolt transmission line to connect a proposed new substation, Oak Ridge Substation, in Fitchburg to the existing Verona Substation.

Public comments on ATC's application will be included in the record the Commission will review to make a decision. The Commission has the authority to approve, deny or modify the application. Citizens are encouraged to attend one of the hearings, which are scheduled for:
